

# Now Available: Clean and Conserve Education Materials

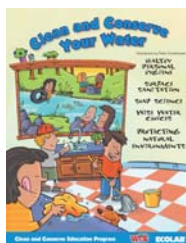

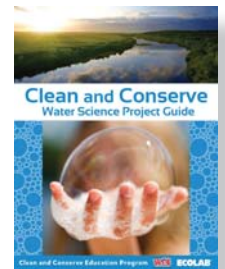
- The **Clean and Conserve Activity Guide for Educators** containing five water conservation and hygiene lessons designed for audiences aged six and up.



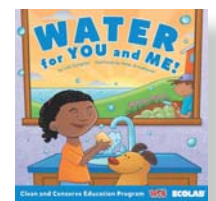
- The **Clean and Conserve Your Water** children's activity booklet to introduce water hygiene and conservation topics to elementary and middle-school-aged children.
